

# SaskEnergy Entering Scholarships

#### The SaskEnergy Scholarship, valued at \$2,500 is open to first year students pursuing one of the following degrees:

- Bachelor of Engineering
- Bachelor of Commerce
- Bachelor of Arts in English, History or Political Science
- Bachelor of Science in these disciplines: Renewable Resource Management, Economics, Computer Science, Environmental Earth Sciences, Geological Sciences, Land Use and Environmental Studies, Public Administration.

#### **Candidates must:**

- have resided in Saskatchewan for a minimum of 12 consecutive months preceding the date of application
- have achieved a minimum academic average of 80% in the preceding year of study while enrolled as a full-time student
- maintain enrolment as a full-time student (18 credit units) in the year the award is received
- demonstrate financial need
- submit a statement of no more than three pages attesting to leadership skills and community involvement, which includes a 50-word biography.

Candidates may receive only one of the SaskEnergy Scholarships or the SaskEnergy Scholarships for Aboriginal Students in any given academic year.
