

## What is tuition?

Tuition is the dollar amount charged in exchange for instruction. It provides access to basic services associated with instruction, such as instructor salaries, basic classroom space and an email address.

Tuition is set using five principles identified in the [Tuition and Fees Authorization Policy](#). Rates in the table above reflect a typical student course offering within the program.

For full-time undergraduate students, a typical student's program includes classes offered by different colleges, so the average tuition cost to students may reflect a blended rate of different tuition categories and covers eight months (September – April). For graduate students, a typical student is enrolled in a full-time thesis program and is continuously enrolled throughout the year.

For a vast majority of programs, the international tuition is the domestic rate multiplied by 4.84 (undergraduate) or 2.25 (master's).

## What are fees?

Student fees are assessed to maintain important supports and services. Fees are the amount paid by students to cover expenses that are not considered part of normal instructional costs. The athletic, recreation and student well-being and services fee fund specific university activities. The other fees are collected for the USSU and GSA to fund their operations and related activities. The list below does not include course fees.
